My name is Bob Biamonte. I am the Mgr of the Airport Medical Offices @ JFK. We have three offices and perform high volume drug and alcohol testing. I received a letter from LabCorp advising us we will have to establish new accounts with them for each Testing Authority. LabCorp states in the letter as per SAMHSA changes, we need separate COC's and accounts for each authority such as, FAA, FRA, FTA, FMCSA, etc. Please tell me if this is true? Would we need a DOT and Non-Dot for each authority? How the authority would be identified on each COC? Does this imply we may go from 2 accounts to possibly more than 10 for 1 lab?!! Why can't codes be established on 1 account for each Testing Authority? Please help.
