I have read you presentation from the DTAB June 2-3, 2009 meeting, regarding the 2010 Federal Custody and Control Form (CCF) Update.

In your presentation it is indicated that these "new" CCF's will be in effect May 1, 2010. I would like to confirm this date, as my business is a DOT collection facility. We specialize in conducting the specimen collection and completing the Chain of Custody Form.

I would also like to know if there will be any awareness and/or refresher training required for these new CCF's? I know (from past experience) that many collectors have no clue about the Federal Regulations or Guidelines, such as understanding in Step 1: Specify Testing Authority ___HHS, ___NRC ___DOT-Agency ___FAA, ___FMCSA, FRA, etc.....many collectors (because I am a trainer and have experienced this) do not even know what DOT stands for!

So, if you could either email me to confirm this date for the new CCF's to go into effect, or tell me where I can find this information.

I would like this information because this is our core business and I like to stay on top of any changes.
