Following are the comments on the Proposed Revisions to the Federal Drug Testing Custody and Control Form (CCF). I am a Certified Professional Collector and Trainer at a hospital that provides collection site services, and a member of the Drug & Alcohol Testing Industry Association (DATIA).

Comments on the proposed mandatory guidelines-

1. In Step 1, C. In addition to Donor SSN or Employee I.D. No., add Donor/Employee Driver's License No. as a third option. The Driver's License Number is unique to each person, and may be useful in the future for data gathering events. I have had many Donors/Employees who hesitate to provide their SSN because of identity theft issues, and some employers do not assign Employee I.D. No.
2. I support the comments submitted by DATIA.
