Below are the comments on the revised Federal Drug Testing Custody and Control Form (CCF)

The SAMSHA as the lead in the Federal Drug Testing Program should look into and promote the use of an electronic generated CCF (eCCF) to be used and generated at the collection site. The eCCF could be printed by laser printer and would contain all of the necessary language and legal required information. This would greatly enhance the collection process, still providing a unique specimen ID number, eliminate the lost CCF at the collection site and reducing the errors. This method would still require an original donor signature. An encrypted internet software programs would allow you to preregister the collection info, route the eCCF to the Lab and MRO once the collection process has been completed, maintaining a safe and direct link from start to finish.
